

Gloucestershire & Warwickshire Steam Railway with Fish & Chip Lunch.

Wednesday 25th June 2025



The coach leaves Bedford at 9.00 for the Gloucestershire & Warwickshire Steam Railway at Cheltenham stopping on the way for refreshments at the Yarnton Home and Garden Centre in Oxfordshire.

Formerly part of Great Western Railway's main line from Birmingham to Cheltenham, the GWSR is a volunteer operated heritage railway with steam and diesel trains running between Cheltenham Racecourse and Broadway that offer the train travel experience of 50 years ago while passing through some of the most spectacular scenery in the Cotswolds with views to the west the Vale of Evesham, the Malverns and Wales and to the east, right at the side of the track, the Cotswolds climb steeply uphill.

At Cheltenham we board the first-class dining carriage 'Mary' for a scenic 20 mile round trip during which we have an included fish and chip lunch.

We end our journey at Winchcombe where you can have refreshments in their 1950's style cafe before heading back, reaching Bedford approx 18.30.

The cost is £67pp for members & £69pp for non-members.
