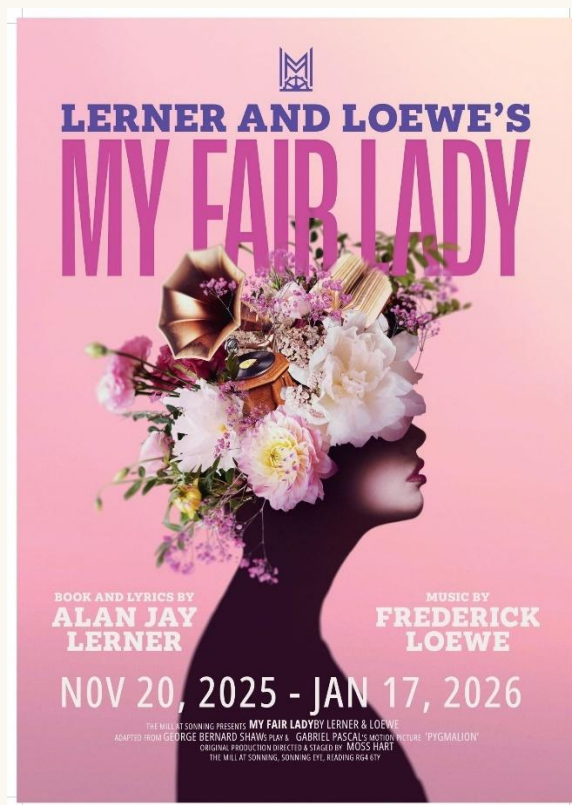


MY FAIR LADY at The Mill at Sonning on Thursday 15th January 2026



Something to look forward to in January, this outing includes a 'Toby' carvery lunch followed by a matinee performance of My Fair Lady at the Mill in Sonning.

My Fair Lady is the story of Eliza Doolittle - the cockney flower girl who speaks in 'yowls' and not 'vowels', plucked off the streets of London by the arrogant Professor Higgins declaring he can pass her off as a Duchess in six months with an unforgettable score including songs 'Wouldn't It Be Lovely?', 'On The Street Where You Live' and 'I Could Have Danced All Night'. The performance is directed by Joseph Picher and is a revival of his captivating West End production from 2017.

The coach will leave Bedfont at 10.30 for the 'Toby' in Lower Early where we will have an included carvery lunch (drinks at own cost) and then move on to the theatre where the bar will be open to buy drinks before the start of the show at 2pm & in the interval.

We arrive back at Bedfont at around 5.30pm.
