On leaving the train we will have a tea/coffee pit stop in the Smith & Western restaurant next door before heading to Scotney Castle.

Scotney Castle is nestled in the Bewl Valley and designated a Site of Special Scientific Interest with a ruined medieval moated castle, Victorian mansion house and one of the top ten formal gardens in England plus woodland and parkland that's free to explore and comes to life in spring with daffodils, rhododendrons, azaleas and magnolias, and there's an accessible, free courtyard area with a tea shop that has indoor and outdoor seating, a Visitor Centre with displays on the wildlife to be found nearby, a well-stocked gift shop that includes products from the Estate and a 2nd hand book shop.

Admission to the house and formal gardens are not included in our visit as standard however can be arranged for anyone who is interested at an additional cost of £14, or as this is a National Trust property it's free for anyone who has NT membership.
